CO TH Responsibilities and Activities

- CO TH has 2 voting members on the AACPM Board of Directors to serve as the voice for AACPM teaching hospital members.
- CO TH has administrative responsibility for the AACPM CASPR residency application and match program and its interview program.
- CO TH has representation on the Council of Podiatric Medical Education (CPME) Resident Review Committee (RRC), National Board for Podiatric Medical Education (NBPME), CPME 320 Ad Hoc, and the ACFAS Post-Graduate Affairs (PGA) Committee.
- CO TH established and has authority for the Stewart J. Bass Resident Rescue Fund. The fund provides financial assist to residents placed in AACPM teaching hospital podiatric residency programs who find themselves displaced due to program closure.
